	<p>Food and Hemp Products; Providing that a marijuana testing laboratory may acquire hemp and hemp extract only from certain businesses; revising requirements for the sale and distribution of hemp extract; prohibiting businesses or food establishments from possessing hemp or hemp extract products that are attractive to children; prohibiting a business permitted to sell hemp or hemp extract from being located in certain areas; providing a penalty for hemp extract possessed, manufactured, delivered, held, offered for sale, distributed, or sold by certain entities in violation of specified provisions, etc. APPROPRIATION: \$2,000,000 Effective Date: 10/1/2025</p>

	<p>Beverage Law: Authorizes the transferring of malt beverages &amp; other alcoholic beverages to licensed facility; authorizes craft breweries to sell &amp; deliver certain number of barrels of malt beverages to licensed vendor; authorizes craft breweries to conduct tastings &amp; sales of malt beverages at specified events; requires Division of Alcoholic Beverages &amp; Tobacco of DBPR to issue permit for such events; authorizes craft breweries that deliver malt beverages to transport such beverages; provides for distribution agreement between beer distributor &amp; craft brewery; provides for territory representation by distributors who enter into distribution agreements; requires craft brewery to repurchase its product upon termination of distribution agreement; requires arbitration of specified disputes; authorizes transfer of beer or malt beverages between contract brewer &amp; contracting brewer in specified amount pursuant to contract brewing agreement; provides that licensed manufacturer seeking to engage in contract brewing must meet certain requirements; requires specified qualification &amp; submitting of certain information before engaging in alternating proprietorship brewing. 	Hemp Extract Products: Revises & provides conditions for manufacture, delivery, hold, offer for sale, distribution, & retail sale of hemp extract products; requires manufacturers, distributors, & retailers of hemp extract products to maintain certain records; prohibits DACS from granting permission to remove or use certain hemp extract products until it determines that such hemp extract products comply with state law; provides appropriations. Effective Date: October 1, 2025

Effective Date: October 1, 2025

	Craft Breweries; Defining the terms “barrel” and “craft brewery”; providing that malt beverages and other alcoholic beverages that are manufactured under contract or by an alternating proprietorship by another licensed manufacturer may be transferred to a licensed facility; authorizing a craft brewery to transport malt beverages in vehicles owned or leased by the manufacturer or persons the manufacturer has disclosed in writing to the division; requiring distribution agreements between a beer distributor and a craft brewery to be in writing, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2025
